Dear Sir or Madam:

Re: Objection to the use of A&W logo and profile

It has come to our attention that your website page canadianfreestuff.com is using the A&W logo as well as the A&W name and brand to promote your coupon codes service. A photo of a page from your website is enclosed for your reference.

A & W Food Services of Canada Inc. ("Food Services") is the exclusive licensee of the very well-known registered A&W trademarks for use in association with quick service restaurants. These trademark registrations confer the exclusive right to use the trademarks throughout Canada. Anyone using these trademarks or logo trademark, who has not been authorized by Food Services, is deemed to infringe on these trademark rights.

We consider the A&W trademarks to be very valuable assets, in respect of which we have no alternative other than to prevent all unauthorized use of any trademark deemed to be infringed by anyone who uses the same or a confusing trademark.

Food Services has not authorized canadianfreestuff.com to use the A&W logo or brand to promote its coupon codes service. Further, Food Services is not part of the canadianfreestuff.com network as the website appears to suggest.

Food Services assumes that the unauthorized use of the A&W logo on the canadianfreestuff.com website as well as the creation of a profile page for Food Services was inadvertent. We ask that you immediately stop using the A&W logo on your website and remove any suggestion that Food Services is part of the canadianfreestuff.com network, including the profile page created for Food Services. Please confirm in writing that canadianfreestuff.com will fully discontinue all use of the A&W logo as well as the A&W name and brand or any other trademarks, trade name or words likely to be confusing with an A&W trademark.

Given the serious implications of this matter, we appreciate your written reply no later than **July 6, 2018**, failing which, we will have no alternative other than to seek legal remedies to enforce and protect Food Services' trademark rights.
